Overview

This course is designed to upskill volunteers, regardless of previous experience, to be competent enough to run a safe, engaging, and enjoyable archery taster session. The day aims to provide you with all the tools and knowledge to begin running sessions with us, then, given practice, an assessment for a permit can be made in the future.

The course will run from 09:30am, and we hope to wrap up at about 5:00pm. This finish time will depend on how many questions are asked etc, so the finish time could be slightly different, but we will do our best to stick to these timings.

Equipment

For safety when participating in archery, please ensure you bring with you:

- Long sleeved clothing
- Closed-toe footwear (ie. Trainers or walking boots, **Not** crocks, flip flops or sandals)
- Any long hair will need to be tied back when shooting, so please bring hair bobbles.
- All above the waist piercings will need to be removed, including all earrings, tongue, and nose piercings. Please speak to an instructor if your piercing cannot be removed.
- Please dress for the weather, as we will be outdoors, come rain or shine

NB: All archery and personal safety equipment will be provided.

Food

No food or drink is provided, so you should bring a packed lunch, snacks & drinks with you.

Consent

All participants must complete and hand in a consent form before activities commence. The health and consent form can be downloaded from our website: <https://adventure.notts-scouts.org.uk>

Additional Requirements

Participants will not be permitted to take part if they are under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

Permits

This weekend is to provide training to be able to run a safe and engaging taster session for young people. Assessments for permits will be conducted at a later date through a practical running of taster sessions at the centre. More information will be provided by your archery instructors following the training day.

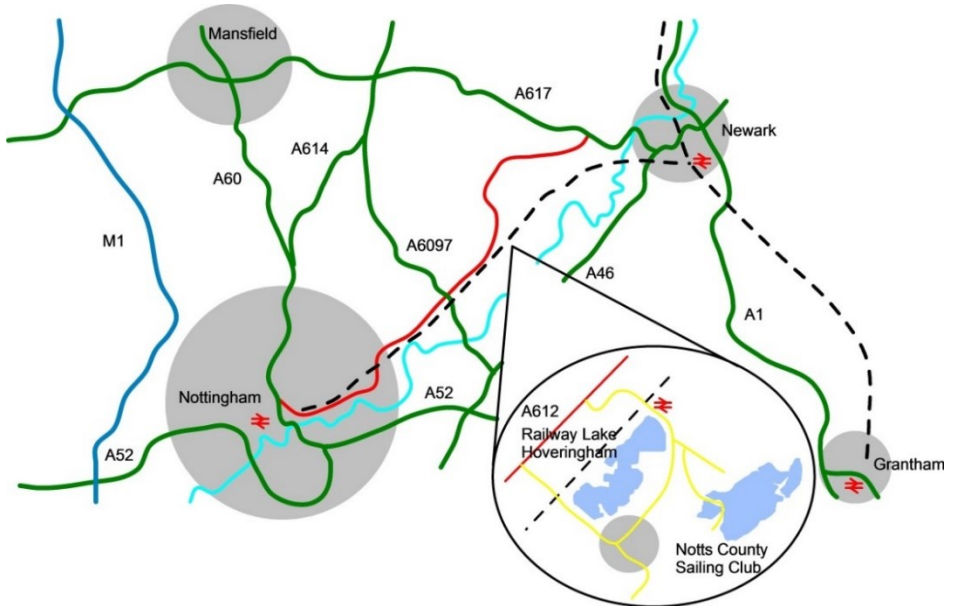
